Asbestos Awareness Training

Asbestos exposure can cause a number of deadly diseases and they can take a long time to develop—up to 40 years. Asbestos-related diseases are the #1 cause of work-related death for people who have worked in Ontario construction. If you work in the building trades, then you may be exposed to asbestos

This program teaches participants how to identify locations where asbestos may be present and find sections of the asbestos regulation that deal with the classification of asbestos work.

Course Objectives

On completion of this 1/2 day course participants will have:

- An awareness of hazards of asbestos
- An awareness of the health effects of asbestos exposure, and enable workers to protect themselves and others
- Familiarization of the Regulations that apply to this hazard
- Understanding the purpose of the Asbestos Management Program
- An understanding of Friable, Potentially Friable and Non Friable Asbestos
- Awareness of Type 1, 2, 3 Work Procedures

The program involves a slide presentation and video review. Each participant will complete classroom exercises and reviews.

Who should attend this workshop?

All workers on projects where asbestos may be present.

A record of completion will be provided to successful participants.
