JHSC Part 2 Workplace Specific Training

JHSC Part 2 workplace Specific training, the employer is required to select a training program that provides training in a minimum of 6 hazards that are relevant to the committee member's workplace. Training is based on the application of Recognize, Assess, Control and Evaluate (RACE) methodology

Part 2 Workplace Specific Course Duration: 2 days or 13 hours and must be completed within 12 months of Part 1 training or obtain a one-time extension due to extenuating circumstances.

After successful completion of the required Part 2 training modules, the training provider will notify the Ministry of Labour, Training Skills Development (MLTSD) that the participant has successfully completed the training to become a Certified Member of the JHSC. At that time, participants will be able to download their certificate from Skillspass.

Certified members trained under the new Standards will be required to take Refresher training every three years to maintain certification status, or may obtain a one-time exemption for an active JHSC member.

A reminder email through Skillspass will be sent when a learner has sixmonths left to complete refresher training to maintain certification status.
