WHMIS 2015

WHMIS is in a period of transition between two hazard communication regimes - WHMIS 1988 and WHMIS 2015 (which incorporates the GHS). During the transition period workers need to be trained on the old and new version of WHMIS.

WHMIS is a Canada-wide information system, using labels, Safety Data Sheets, and worker education programs, to ensure that workers are aware of the hazards of the materials they handle. The goal of WHMIS 2015 training is to ensure that workers are:

- Informed
- Aware of the hazards in their workplace
- Know how to protect themselves from exposure to hazards.
