Course Prerequisites

You must have a learner ID # and bring it with you to your training.

Participants will:

- Review basic working at heights awareness ranging from employer and supervisor obligations
- Understand working at heights-related hazards, along with safeguards and procedures designed to protect workers.
- Review fall protection equipment and systems.
- Demonstrate how to inspect equipment, don and doff a harness, and maintain 100% tie-off.

Successful completion of this four hour refresher training will re-validate WAH training compliance for three years.

At the conclusion of the training the student will receive a certificate from the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training, and Skills Development on Skillspass™.
