FIRST AID: INJURIES

Bone and Soft Tissue Injuries

Perform Scene Survey. Call 911 if necessary.

Do not remove casualty from scene site unless necessary.

Perform **Primary Survey**.

Control external bleeding – carefully if the bone is protruding.

Support and steady the injured part while waiting for Emergency Medical Care to arrive.

To reduce pain and swelling, **apply an ice pack** – fifteen (15) minutes ON and fifteen (15) minutes off.

If possible, elevate the injured part to reduce swelling.

Apply gentle **compression** with bandage.

Reassure casualty, monitoring closely for any change in condition.

Do not give the casualty anything to eat or drink.

Provide ongoing care until medical help arrives.
